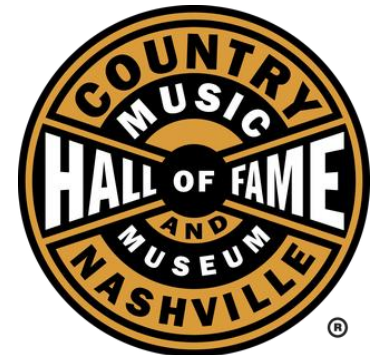

## Itinerary

### **Friday, December 11**

Our two night stay there includes rooms facing their beautifully decorated atrium. Late this afternoon we board the motorcoach and travel to Minneapolis where we spend the night so we do not have to get up so early to get on our flight. Overnight Minneapolis

### **Saturday, December 12**

Breakfast on your own at the airport. We board our flight to Nashville this morning. Early afternoon we check in to the Gaylord Opryland Resort for a two night stay. Discover the magic of the holidays. From the breathtaking ICE! frozen attraction and dazzling light displays to classic traditions like ice tubing, gingerbread house decorating, and photos with Santa, Gaylord Opryland transforms into a festive wonderland perfect for creating unforgettable memories. Today we enjoy a flat bottomed boat ride in the Atrium of the hotel. With over 4.5 acres of indoor decorations you can wander through millions of holiday lights and capture festive pictures. The Delta Riverboat Ride at Gaylord Opryland Resort in Nashville is a 12–14 minute, guided tour on a flat-bottomed boat through a 4.5-acre indoor atrium. The boat navigates a quarter-mile river containing water from 1,700+ rivers, featuring botanical gardens, waterfalls, and, during the holidays, 5 million lights! This afternoon we participate in their signature attraction; ICE! featuring "A Charlie Brown Christmas" brings beloved scenes to life through colorful, colossal ice sculptures. Race down their exhilarating ice tubing lanes for frosty thrills. An evening Christmas meal followed by POMP, SNOW & CIRQUEumstance, their spectacular new holiday cirque show featuring world-class acrobatics, original music, and dazzling productions at the Opryland Hotel. ### **Sunday, December 13**

Included breakfast at the hotel. This morning will be yours to explore the sights of our Grand Hotel. The General Jackson will take us on a luncheon cruise on the Cumberland River during the middle of the day. This evening we include a Nashville Christmas Light tour followed by a Vince Gill and Amy Grant concert at the Ryman Auditorium. We then check into the Drury Inn Airport which is our hotel for the night. Overnight Drury Inn Nashville. (B)

Breakfast is included at the hotel today. Following breakfast we fly back home to Minneapolis where a motorcoach will be waiting to take us back to Western MN. We hope you enjoyed the sights and sounds of Nashville, their wonderful lights and shows. (B)
